- **Michigan Tech** – Your MTU trail system is groomed and tracked. Expect incredible Spring conditions. Pine loop is covered in pine needles and Linden has oak leaves and dirty snow from dust blowing in off Sharron Ave. Spent some more time on Birch this morning covering up the thin spot It might still be a bit rough. Have a great day! (3/26/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Good evening/morning skiers! We got out this lovely night and were able to drag the entire system, minus Relentless (equipment issues once again). The classic tracks are holding up beautifully even with the warmer weather. This morning looks like a good chance to ski and might even get a bit of snow. Enjoy skiing! (3/26/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Loops 1-3 and 5 have been groomed and are in great shape. Enjoy the sunshine. (3/23/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - The trails are rolled and tracked again as of 3:15 this afternoon. We had to run with tracks down the whole way, but tried our best to keep them on the sides of the hills. (3/17/2026)
