- **Michigan Tech** –All main trails were groomed and tracked this morning for your enjoyment. Expect excellent conditions with a light dusting of lake effect. Tolkien and the River will be addressed tomorrow. We ran out of time. (2/26/2026)
- **Swedetown** – All of the trails have been refreshed with the Husky this morning. Skate and classic tracks are looking pretty sharp. With a gentle falling snow this morning it's guaranteed to be a beautiful day on the trails here at Swedetown. Have a great ski! (2/26/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Loops 1, 2, 3, and 5 have been packed but are not rideable. 4 has been buried in snow and can't be ridden until the snow settles. (2/23/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - Ran the 5' Ginzu followed by the track setter. The tracks look great and the forest is beautiful! (2/25/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - While the trails have likely been used, I have not gone over them myself. With the continuous snowfall and my work schedule, it made no sense to go over them until it settles especially after Friday's quick warm-up to come. I'll be out Saturday panking the snowshoe trails. (2/25/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – All trails are in good condition. Some new tracks up and around the churning rapids area. (2/26/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - Trails were still pretty soft on Thursday, despite lots of effort from our groomers (rideable with very low tire pressure). A brief warmup is expected on Friday, so we plan to regroom Friday evening before it freezes Friday night. This should set us up for good riding conditions on Saturday and Sunday. (2/27/2026)
- **Eagle Harbor Ski Trails** – Still catching up from storms. Groomed all but the well head loop. Enjoy! (2/22/2026)
