- **Michigan Tech** – I thought I had a window of opportunity to groom but the four wheeler tracks were leaving unattractive impressions in the trail, so I got off the trail. The classic tracks have survived thanks to all the people that skied in them. I did get Isle Royale, Superior and Birch rolled. It looks like we'll have a couple more warm days and then perhaps winter will return. (3/7/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Swedetown Trails Grooming Report at 8:21am Mar 11, 2026 Good morning all! Apologies, groomers are getting going later this morning than I would have liked to. Heading out now, will send an update later. Trails will be groomed and tracked with the Husky. (3/11/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Loops 1-3 and 5 got groomed today, 4 should be open later this week. (3/10/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - Stirred in 2 to 3 inches of new snow with the 7' ginzu and tracked the trails. (3/10/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - Should stay off the trails until colder weather with hopefully some snow to mitigate some of the damage caused by a user being on parts of the trails when it was too soft. (3/4/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – Trails have not been groomed. We can't do much with the frozen surface. At best we only get a few hours of skiing out of several hours of work. Waiting on snow. (3/4/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - Trails were groomed early Tuesday morning. Used the Vplow to push the fresh snow off. As of 7:00am the trail surface is still breakable in some places as it hasn't fully frozen yet, but the temperature is supposed to stay below freezing today so hopefully it will get harder. Riding should be ok on Tuesday afternoon and evening. (3/10/2026)
- **Eagle Harbor Ski Trails** – Most trails were groomed Friday evening while the snow was soft, before the freeze. There were some ruts and footprints that mostly got smoothed out. Riding should be great Saturday and Sunday. (2/27/2026)
- **Copper Harbor Trails Club "End of the Road Trails"** – We had a few trucks drive down the Mandan yesterday and rutted it up good. Got out this morning to fill them in as best I could but there isn't much else we can do until it freezes up again. Conditions are very soft and wet out there. (3/8/2026)
- **Copper Harbor Trails** - Great conditions Hard pack and corduroy (2/4/2026)
