- **Michigan Tech** – We just got done grooming and tracking all the main trails with the two snow cats. We had a fresh 4 to 5 inches of snow yesterday which made the grooming really pleasurable. We're gonna have second breakfast and then we'll go groom and track Tolkien. It's another perfectly beautiful winter day. Hope to see you skiing. (1/11/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Good morning! We got about 4-6 inches of powdery snow overnight, which has groomed in gorgeously this morning. All ski trails were groomed and tracked with the Husky. It is still likely to be pretty soft, but will hopefully set up as the day goes on. We will be out again in the morning as there is a bit more snow forecasted for tonight. Companion tracks are set on Cedar, Tamarack, Valley, and Greenstone. The Multi-use-trail (MUT) Loops have been freshly groomed and tracked with snowmobile implements, as well. Happy skiing!! - **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Good morning! We got a bit of snow last night, but it groomed in smooth this morning. Loops 1-5 are open and should set up nicely as the day goes on. Loop 5 is still soft in places, so please be aware of any diviots or holes you are leaving. Thank you and enjoy the ride! (1/11/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - Knives down on the ginzu over the former tracks and new tracks set. (1/11/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - All trails have been broken open. Snow depth has dropped to 17" in the hardwoods. (1/8/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – It was very icy but it groomed up nicely. If we get some snow over night we'll groom again Sunday morning. (1/10/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - Trails were groomed Saturday evening after most of the new snow fell. We used the Vplow to push the fresh snow to the side, so riding should be pretty good on Sunday. (1/11/2026)
- **Eagle Harbor Ski Trails** – Trails in great shape! (1/5/2026)
