- **Michigan Tech** – All main Trails were groomed and tracked with the Pisten Bully this morning. Tolkien and the River Trail will have to wait till tomorrow due to time constraints. The overnight snow mixed in well with the icy base and trails set up quickly. Expect Great conditions today if you brave the temperatures. (1/14/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Good morning all! All ski trails were groomed and tracked with the Husky, to groom in the 1-3 inches of drifted powder we got overnight and this morning. Conditions directly behind the groomer are excellent, but it is continuing to snow throughout the morning so it is quickly getting covered up. I left Eds, Cedar, Tamarack, and Birch until last today so they would have less snow on them, for those that like to stay close to the chalet. Multi use trail (MUT) loops were also freshly groomed and tracked today! Enjoy your ski everyone! (1/14/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Some sections of the trail may be covered in snow drifts. (1/14/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - Knives down on the ginzu over the former tracks and new tracks set. (1/11/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - All trails have been broken open. Snow depth has dropped to 17" in the hardwoods. (1/8/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – Trails are in great shape. We'll be grooming again early on Saturday unless it snows much before then. (1/14/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - Trails groomed Wednesday afternoon. Used the Vplow to push off the soft snow. Riding should be very good Wednesday evening and Thursday if we don't get too much new snow. (1/14/2026)
