- **Michigan Tech** – Due to illnesses affecting our workforce your MTU trails will not be groomed today. We apologize. We do plan on grooming tomorrow. (1/2/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Good afternoon everyone! Grooming is finally done for the day, I took the Husky through the full system to groom + set track. Its looking really gorgeous out here, with some fresh powder falling throughout the day. Companion tracks are set on most of Cedar, Tamarack, Valley, and Greenstone. Enjoy your ski! (12/31/2025)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Happy New Years Eve! Loops 1-3 have been dragged again to smooth out the nice lake effect and continue to pack the base nice and solid. A bit chilly, but the sun is out so enjoy! (12/31/2025)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - Following up on our earlier dragging and rolling, the trails are now groomed and tracked. (12/31/2025)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - I did not go out after the 'Blizzard' event. I instead waited for this past evening's 6" of fluff before heading out. I was fairly sure that the prior wetter event would prove to be the new base for the trails. And so, it was today. The Blue Trail is fully opened. The Green Trail is 3/4 opened from the Yellow trail junction across to both sides of the Blue Trail's bottom. The Yellow Trail's lower half, the most commonly used trail, is opened. The Yellow Trail's upper half will probably have wind-driven obliterations near LaTendress's fields (to the NW) and McKrain's fields (to the North). I work tomorrow, so the rest of the trails will be opened Thursday. Perhaps with the trail system getting more use this year, some other snowshoers will break open other parts before then. Snow depth is about 15-16" in the hardwoods and open terrain. New snowfall is about 6" in those two enviros but only 2" under the hemlock. (12/31/2025)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – Majority of trails have been dragged and tracked. (1/2/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - Trails were groomed again Wednesday night. Almost everything got two additional passes to pack down the fresh snow and has hopefully firmed up with the cold temperatures overnight. (1/1/2026)
- **Copper Harbor Trails Club "End of the Road Trails"** – After some early season malfunctions we are up and running at the end of the road! Things are looking good and we will be adding additional loops on East Bluff as the season progresses. Expect more frequent grooming this year as we have additional resources and some new equipment!
