- **Michigan Tech** – Good Morning! All main trails will be groomed with the Pisten Bully This morning. We started in the Upper Trails at 5, headed into the Lowers at 7 and we will finish up in Competition around 10. Expect excellent conditions and great kick in the tracks due to the frigid temperatures. Tolkien and the River Trail were groomed yesterday and are in good shape. (1/26/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Good morning all, groomers are having some delays this morning but will be getting going very soon. We really wish we could reset track today but there are some equipment issues that badly need addressing today before we can do so. Tracks will be reset tomorrow. (1/26/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Loops 1-3 got dragged this afternoon after it got above zero for a bit. The trails look gorgeous this evening with the sun shining. Bundle up and enjoy! (1/24/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - 7 inches new snow (1/17/2026)
