- **Michigan Tech** – All your MTU trails will be groomed and tracked this morning. I started in Upper then Competition and we are headed down to the lower trails Presently. Tolkien and the River Trail were addressed as well. The skate deck and track set are firming up nicely. Conditions will be excellent today. (1/29/2026)
- **Swedetown** – The sun was out for a few minutes this morning then the lake effect snow machine fired right back up! The skiing should be beautiful nonetheless! The whole system was groomed and tracked with the Husky. I was able put companion tracks on Tamarack Loop only today. There are a lot of broken tree branches on the trails from all the heavy snow, if you come across any please throw them off the trail, thank you in advance! The MUT trails were dragged and a classic track was set. The trails should be skiing great, have fun! (1/29/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - All trails have been dragged twice. (1/28/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - Half last night and half this morning (1/30/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - After my first trip out, I decided to feast, take a nap, and head back out again. The Yellow trail is completed. The Orange will be broken open on Monday. (1/24/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – Close in stuff has new tracks. (1/30/2026)
