- **Michigan Tech** – Due to illness there is no one available to operate cats and groom this morning. I sent a Crew member over to Tolkien this morning as we have not had time to address the trails over there. We do have someone coming in to groom this afternoon. We appreciate your patience. (1/5/2026)
- **Swedetown** – The 4-5" of new lake effect snow groomed in beautifully this morning. Our whole system has been groomed and tracked with the snowcat. The MUT loops have also been groomed and new tracks set. It's a "skiing in a snowglobe" kinda day! Get out and enjoy the trails! (1/4/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Good morning!! Loops 1-4 have been dragged to back in the fluffy lake effect we got this morning and last night. Trails are looking beautiful this morning and it should be a wonderful day to ride. Enjoy!! (1/4/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - At least a couple inches of new snow. (1/3/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - Neighbor opened the Red Trail, and I finished the upper Yellow Trail and all of the Orange Trail today. Definitely a breezy day. Re-walked the far upper Blue Trail because of drifting. Other trails were done yesterday. (1/2/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – All trails tracked (1/3/2026))
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** -Close to 6 inches of new snow on Sunday night. Trails are not groomed on Monday morning. We'll be out grooming on Monday evening. (1/5/2026)
- **Eagle Harbor Ski Trails** - Slow start, but fairly good coverage. Still cutting small saplings and low hanging branches after the heavy wet snow a few weeks back, but getting there. Should be able to get out to Wellhead and Shadows in the next day or so. Enjoy the snow! (1/2/2026)
- **Copper Harbor Trails Club "End of the Road Trails"** – After some early season malfunctions we are up and running at the end of the road! Things are looking good and we will be adding additional loops on East Bluff as the season progresses. Expect more frequent grooming this year as we have additional resources and some new equipment!
