- **Michigan Tech** – Good Morning! 35 degrees presently at the MTU trails. Unfortunately it is too warm and our base is too soft to support grooming equipment. The forecast is for temperatures to drop this evening and with a snow event tomorrow we will be out grooming in earnest. Today, expect good conditions although they will be soft. "It's always a good day to go skiing." (1/9/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Grooming is slightly delayed this morning to let any precip finish falling, but we will be getting going soon. (1/9/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Good morning!! Loops 1-4 have been dragged back in the fluffy lake effect we got this morning and last night. Trails are looking beautiful this morning and it should be a wonderful day to ride. Enjoy!! (1/4/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - About a half foot of new snow dragged, rolled, and tracked! (1/5/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - All trails have been broken open. Snow depth has dropped to 17" in the hardwoods. (1/8/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – All trails rolled, dragged and tracked. (1/5/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - Trails are still in decent condition and rideable with lower tire pressure (less than 5psi). The trails could soften more with warm temps on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons, so morning may be the best time to ride. (1/7/2026)
- **Eagle Harbor Ski Trails** – Trails in great shape! (1/5/2026)
- **Copper Harbor Trails Club "End of the Road Trails"** – A little soft yet but looking good! (1/7/2026)
