Snowmobile Trail Conditions - Ride Right & Ride Sober

#### Keweenaw Snowmobile Club Groomed:

- Limited operations due to low traffic.
- Trail 122 from to Gay—more progress opening, operations have made it to Coal Dock Road.

### KSC Notes from the Trail:

- O Trails 134, 135, 153 have **not been opened** yet. We will continue to cut trees and brush to open them.
- O The culvert to High Rock is full of water holes headed towards High Rock. Ride with caution across the system.
- We will continue to open the system this week. This process will take time due to extensive damage from the ice storm / blizzard.
- Ride with extreme caution. There has been new snow, so expect hazards to be hidden. Ride with caution, expect brush and debris in the trails, rocks, water / wet areas.

#### Snowmobile Trail Closures

- O Portage Lake Lift Bridge snowmobile trail is **CLOSED**.
- Private trails north of Calumet to Copper Harbor are CLOSED until trails can be groomed.
- CLOSED due to logging— Please stay out of these areas or risk permanent trail closure:
  - Trail 130- Between Eagle Harbor and Eagle River. We anticipate the trail opening mid-December.
  - Trail 124- Between Trail 3 at Vansville and the 122/124 Intersection. We anticipate the trail opening January
- Please respect private land owner rights. We can't have a trail system without their support.

## Cross Country Skiing & Fat Tire Trail Updates - Ski conditions provided by KeweenawTrails.com/trail-reports/

- Michigan Tech All the Upper, Competition and lower Trails have a new track set and the skate lanes have been dragged. Please be aware of a strange track set as we are training new folks on track setting. Conditions are Good for as little snow we have. Temps will be hovering around Twenty and should make for some awesome skiing, get to the trails and enjoy. Tolkien is on our radar and we will continue to work on the downed trees and storm debris. Thanks eh!? (12/10/2025)
- Swedetown Happy Tuesday! The new 1.5" of Lake Effect groomed in very nicely. We freshened up the skate deck with the drags and it is setting up nicely. The classic is in great shape for striding today! Enjoy the beautiful trails. (12/9/2025)
- Swedetown Snow Bike No update. (12/1/2025)
- Chassell Ski Trails- The Marinette Street Trailhead is now groomed! (12/9/2025)
- Chassell Snowshoe Trails All the trails have been given a double walk to establish their bases. With a relatively shallow base it shouldn't be surprising to me that sticks show up after being unknowingly walk over the first time. I took a shovel along to put additional snow on the trail where needed to keep it flatter (as opposed being slanted to one side), sudden dips, and either side of smaller logs that normally would have been covered by now.(12/8/2025)
- Churning Rapids & Maasto All cleared trails have been dragged and tracked this morning. Tracks are a little rough from the first track setting but skiing is reported to be good on cleared trails. Trails reported as ungroomed have not yet been cleared of storm damage. (12/5/2025)
- Churning Rapids Snow Bike We have an open loop! High Point Road will be the best access point for now since the ski trails in Churning Rapids are not groomed yet. From the High Point Road Parking area groomed trails include High Point, Basswood Bottoms, Lieblein Lane, Finni Creek, Upper PowPow, top of Thoroughfare, Snow Bike Alley, West Ruby Marsh, Woodsy Lane, Sucky Up, Trillium, Aunt Flo, and High Point Pass. Trails were groomed Sunday morning. It would be best to wait until Sunday afternoon to ride so the snow has time to firm up. (12/7/2025)
