- **Michigan Tech** – We dragged all the skate lanes with the Ginzus this morning and set a new track on the River trail. All the other classic tracks are in superb shape from yesterday. I skied Tolkien late yesterday and that track is in fine shape also. It looks like another perfect winter day, I hope to see y'all out skiing. (12/22/2025)
- **Swedetown** – Happy Solstice Everyone!! Lots more snow (and wind) yesterday to groom today, but the trail is looking beautiful under the new inch of powder that has fallen during grooming this morning. I am happy to report that all ski trails are fully open and groomed and tracked as of today!! I packed Papa Bear and the hilly section of Relentless yesterday, and they set up wonderfully overnight to make for some very nice grooming conditions this morning. The MUT loops also have tracks now! We will continue setting them throughout the winter. Companion tracks (two side by side tracks) have been set on most of Valley, Greenstone, Cedar, and Tamarack, so bring a buddy and come ski! Snowbike riders, thank you for your patience as we work on getting the ski trails open from the Thanksgiving Eve storm, loops 1-3 (now Snow Roll, Snowflake, and Polar Pedal) are now groomed and ready to ride!! We will be pushing to get 4 and 5 (now North Wind and Frostbite) open this week. Enjoy your Ski/ride! A very special THANK YOU to all of the volunteers that have helped us get the trails open this year - it has been a big task with all of the downed trees and brush. (12/21/2025)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Snow bike trails Polar Pedal, Snow Roll, and Snowflake are open. (12/21/2025)
- **Chassell Ski Trails**- Trails look beautiful after last night's snow! (12/21/2025)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - I went out today to do a final walk through most of the trails for a final packing to hopefully solidify the base a bit more before the mild weather arrives. All of the Green, Blue, and Orange trails are done. Bottom half of Yellow done. (12/15/2025)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** – All trails that have been cleared were rolled, dragged and tracked this morning. (12/21/2025)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - We made another grooming pass on Sunday morning. The fresh and windblown snow seems to have packed in fairly well. Riding should be decent on Sunday afternoon and beyond. The xc ski trail is now groomed down Christensen Road to M203, so that is now an option for snow bike trail access. (12/21/2025)
