- **Michigan Tech** – We were able to get some good corduroy on the skate lanes this morning. Track set is still holding up well. Expect soft, wet and slow conditions as the temps rise throughout the day. Tomorrow is not looking good for grooming. We will assess in the morning. Monday we have a snow event and we expect to get the Bully out setting some new track. (12/27/2025)
- **Swedetown** – Tracks were not refreshed today. But still good (12/27/2025)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Good Monday morning everyone! Loops 1-3 have been double dragged this morning to smooth out the dusting of snow from last night. Trails are looking gorgeous this morning so enjoy! (12/22/2025)
- **Chassell Ski Trails**- Trails look beautiful after last night's snow! (12/21/2025)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - All the trails were packed today with my Iverson woodys except for the upper half of the Yellow Trail (on Wednesday). The base is slowly building up, slowly...
