Snowmobile Trail Conditions - Ride Right & Ride Sober

• Keweenaw Snowmobile Club (KSC) Trail Openings:

- Trail 3—Opened more miles from Montreal Meadows and Brockway Mountain. Additional passes from Hancock to Clear Lake.
- o Trail 17—Additional passes.
- Trail 134— Opened from Copper Harbor to Trail 135.
- o Half of Trail 135

• KSC Notes from the Trail:

- The culvert to Highrock is full of water holes headed towards Highrock. Ride with caution across the system.
- We will continue to open the system this week. This process will take time due to extensive damage from the ice storm / blizzard.
- Ride with extreme caution. There has been new snow, so expect hazards to be hidden. Ride with caution, expect brush and debris in the trails, rocks, water / wet areas.

Snowmobile Trail Closures

- Portage Lake Lift Bridge snowmobile trail is CLOSED.
- Private trails north of Calumet to Copper Harbor are CLOSED until trails can be groomed.
- CLOSED due to logging— Please stay out of these areas or risk permanent trail closure:
 - Trail 130- Between Eagle Harbor and Eagle River. We anticipate the trail opening mid-December.
 - Trail 124- Between Trail 3 at Vansville and the 122/124 Intersection. We anticipate the trail opening January
- CLOSED for hunting on private land—Please respect this closure or risk losing the trail:
 - Trail 133
- Please respect private land owner rights. We can't have a trail system without their support.

The Crew is in Competition presently and will head down to the Lowers after that following the same plan. Over all trails are looking quite good even if I would like to more of a base. There are some thin spots on Down Under and down by the river on Tanglewood and Homestead. Lower trails still have some overhanging branches so be aware. Have a great Ski! (12/5/2025)
- Swedetown Good morning! We groomed and re-set track using snowmobile implements today, on all of the trails open so far.
 We were having some snow buildup problems on our equipment today, so watch out for any snow ridges, especially on the intersections. Overall, conditions are pretty good! Reports from skiers are that the tracks are suprisingly fast despite the cold temps, with decent kick. We will be continuing the daily work crew cutting tree damage today from 12 noon to 2:30, continuing to work on opening up Greenstone and Powderhouse. Meet us at the Chalet at 12 or ski out to meet us! Enjoy your ski everyone!(12/4/2025)

- Chassell Ski Trails- Lightly tilted ahead of today's tracking of the approximately 3" of powder.(12/4/2025)
- Chassell Snowshoe Trails 2" of new snow. Lower half of the Yellow Trail has been cleared and broken opened. Orange trail has just one section on the upper south side to be done. Planning to go out Friday to finish the upper Yellow trail. (12/3/2025)

- Churning Rapids City side trails rolled. (12/3/2025)
- Churning Rapids Snow Bike Volunteers have started trying to open the trails, but it has been very slow going with all of the trees
 down after the heavy snow around Thanksgiving. We hope to have some trails groomed by December 6/7 weekend. We could use
 help clearing trails if you can get out for a walk with a loppers or small saw. Most of Churning Rapids still needs to be cleared
