- **Michigan Tech** – All the skate lanes on the main trails were dragged out with the Ginzu this morning. Snow was falling as I was grooming so there's a bit of fluff on the trail. The classic track is in great shape and the fresh snow will make it great for kick. It maybe the last good striding this year, so get out early before for the sun melts it, and have a lot of fun. (3/23/2026)
- **Swedetown** – Good morning all! Grooming was slow going this morning due to the somewhat icy conditions, but turned out beautifully and I am told conditions are excellent. 😊 The full system was groomed and tracked today in the Husky, to grind this icy stuff back into snow and reset both the tracks and skate deck. The Multi Use Loops were groomed and tracked with snowmobile implements last night, so they should be in good shape. Enjoy your ski everyone! (3/23/2026)
- **Swedetown Snow Bike** - Good morning! Its a tad foggy out here at Swedetown, but the trails are golden. I was able to drag 1-3 and 5 to smooth everything out for the afternoon. I would give it time to see if the trails will set up with the warmer temperatures today. If you are leaving ruts/divots, the trail is too soft to be riding on. Please enjoy the trails and the warm temps! (3/20/2026)
- **Chassell Ski Trails** - The trails are rolled and tracked again as of 3:15 this afternoon. We had to run with tracks down the whole way, but tried our best to keep them on the sides of the hills. (3/17/2026)
- **Chassell Snowshoe Trails** - Should stay off the trails until colder weather with hopefully some snow to mitigate some of the damage caused by a user being on parts of the trails when it was too soft. (3/4/2026)
- **Churning Rapids & Maasto** –Hey skiers, all trails have been dragged. I'll be out tomorrow 3/20 setting tracks so they are ready to go for the weekend. Trails are very soft. (3/19/2026)
- **Churning Rapids Snow Bike** - All trails were groomed Friday evening and again Saturday evening. Temps will drop overnight and trails should firm up. Riding should be very good on Sunday. (3/21/2026)
- **Eagle Harbor Ski Trails** – Everything in good shape with lots of snow coverage. Speaking of which, if you travel with hand clippers, don't be afraid to trim some of the small saplings that are encroaching on the trail! Get out there! (3/19/2026)
- **Copper Harbor Trails Club "End of the Road Trails"** – Pre-race grooming continues. The entire East Bluff Meltdown course is now groomed and tracked sections set. Conditions are fantastic. We'll continue with some final touch ups tomorrow before the race and Wander on Saturday. Get out there and enjoy! (3/20/2026)
